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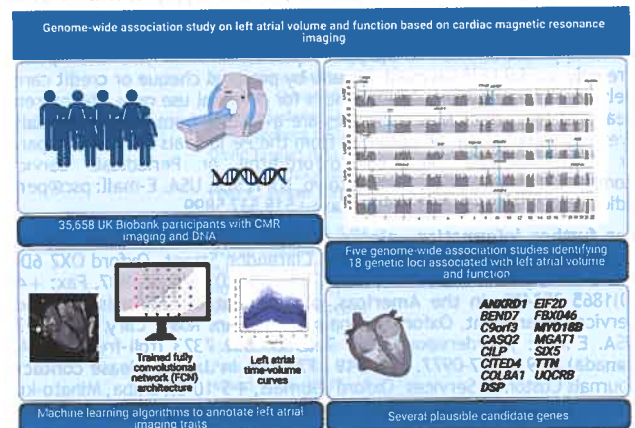
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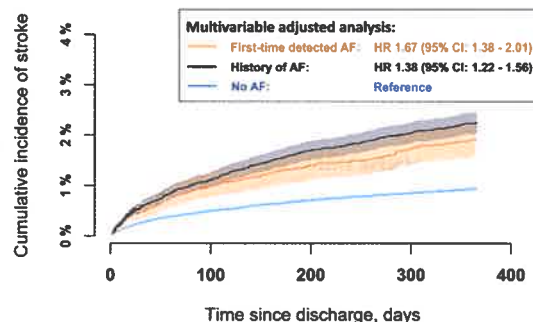

Proportion of patients with prescribed OAC within 3 months of ACS discharge:

First-time detected AF with PCI:	46.3%
First-time detected AF without PCI:	36.0%
History of AF with PCI:	44.2%
