Many indexes can be derived from conventional and ambulatory blood pressure recordings. In a longitudinal population-based cohort study of 11135 adult participants, Yang and colleagues for the International Database on Ambulatory Blood Pressure in Relation for Cardiovascular Outcomes Investigators found that higher 24-hour and night-time blood pressures were associated with mortality and a composite cardiovascular end point.

Patient Assistance Programs for Prescription Drugs

Patient assistance programs subsidize out-of-pocket costs for prescription drugs. Kang and colleagues conducted a descriptive cross-sectional study of the 6 largest independent charities offering 274 disease-specific patient assistance programs and found that most programs required insurance coverage for eligibility. In an Editorial, Kraschel and Curfman explain how patient assistance programs drive up health care costs by providing support for more expensive specialty drugs in lieu of less expensive alternatives.

Lourida and colleagues followed up 196 383 older adults for 1545 433 person-years and found that a healthier lifestyle was associated with a lower risk of dementia for participants at high genetic risk.
